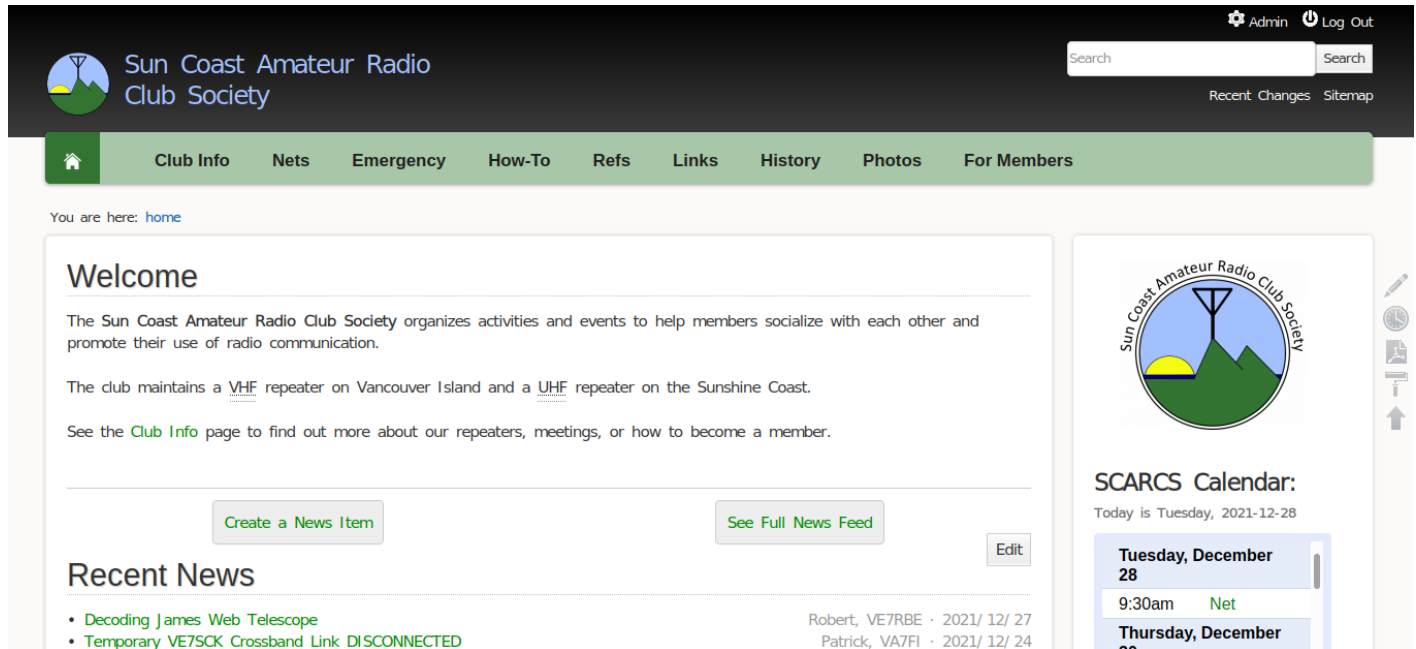


# New Site Template
