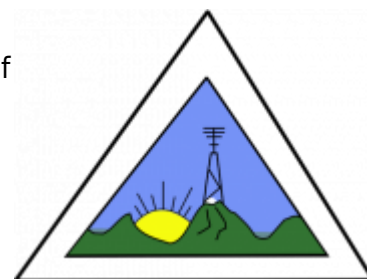


Welcome
