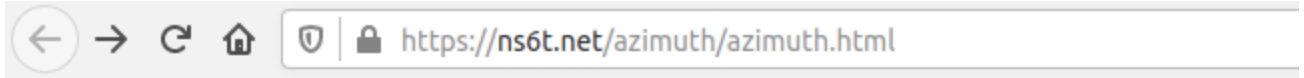


Azimuthal Map

Azimuthal maps are only useful if they are centred at your location. To create one:

- Go to <https://osm.org> and navigate to your location and zoom in as much as possible.
- Copy the last part of the URL. This contains your coordinates.
